Congratulations to Margaret Dredge and thank you for the many years of support to the club. Also, everybody is very excited and happy to welcome to the new Patron of the Men's Bowling Arm, Frank Geritz.

The major focus of the board this year is to rebuild the finances of the club and put ourselves in a position to relay the carpet on green 1 by around the end of next year or early in 2022. I am pleased to say that we have made some positive progress, predominantly aided by Job Keeper, the Cash Flow Boost, and Grants we received. Also, having the Waves bowlers at our club brought in some additional green fees each week.

I would also like to say a very special thank you to all those people that made a special donation to the club during COVID to help keep the club going. Your support and generosity is very much appreciated. Further, to all those people that have helped at the club during and since the shutdown, from taking cans and bottles to recycling, taking care of the greens and gardens, helping to clean the club two days a week, making changes inside the club to support social distancing and other COVID guidelines as required by the Government, and more, I say a very big thank you. Everything you do helps the club enormously.

NEWS FROM THE BOARD

I would like to give you a quick update about some of the things going on or that the Board is focusing on in the next few months. By the time this Pelican Brief goes to press, the new carpet in the bottom part of the club will have been laid. This was kindly made possible by a grant from the Sunshine Coast City Council and by a donation of carpet from the RSL. The bottom part of the club now looks like a million dollars.

Recently the Ladies Bowling Arm held a Forum and Tony gave a 15 minute update of the status of the club, the plans of the board and what we have been working on so far. Tony will give a similar update at the Men's Bowling Arm AGM coming up in November. Many thanks to LBA and MBA for the opportunity to present information from the Board.

The Board has a number of initiatives underway to increase the number of Social Patrons coming to the club. We will soon be undertaking a letter box with flyers for the club and we will be asking members if they can drop flyers in the letter boxes in their streets. We are also going to post more information on Facebook about the bistro and bar and Social Patron aspect of the club. We have some ads in the Neighbourhood Watch newsletter as well as the Pelican Waters Land Sales newsletter. Further, we are updating some of the signage around the club to promote the club.




