
Patron's Day was hugely supported with 96 players. Frank and Gwen enjoyed the day immensely.

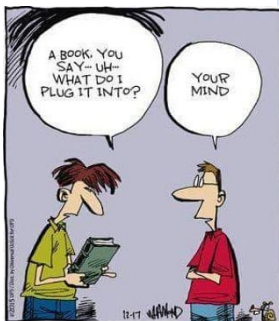

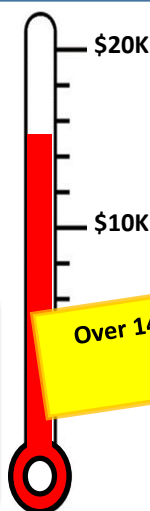
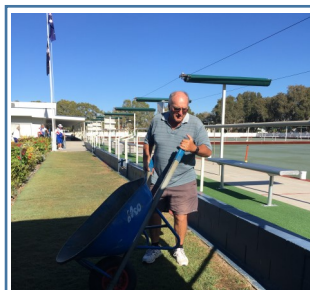
MBA Report
