#### Chairperson's Report.

The AGM was held earlier in the month, on 6 April, and was very well attended by members. Thanks to all those who came along. The new Board was elected: Tony Carter (Chairperson), Clive Dixon (Vice Chairperson), Jon Butler (Secretary), Phil Marshall (Treasurer) and Directors Helen McGlynn, Robyn Schey, Pam Bishop, Lloyd Hawkins and Mal Smith. Thanks to Denise for her efforts last year and to the other people who nominated to be on the Board.

Congratulations to Phil Marshall who was elected as a life member at the AGM. There is a special article in this Pelican Brief about Phil, so I won't say too much here, only to say his election as a life member is extremely well deserved.

At the AGM, it was agreed to spend money to install a new increased capacity solar system. We won't initiate this until we hear back on a grant application that was submitted to obtain funds to do this. The new solar system will have the benefit of reducing our yearly electricity bills, while at the same time being more environmentally friendly.

The next major initiative that the Board will prepare for is the replacement of the green outside the club house. There is no specific timeframe for this as the longer we can wait before actually replacing the green, the more savings we can accumulate towards the purchase, meaning less of a loan and so easier for us to replace the second green and then achieve other goals the Board has. The main determinant for when we replace the green is when we have the funds or when it is determined the green is no longer suitable for being able to play good bowls on.

With Summer now behind us and as we head into the cooler months, the Board would still like to remind all bowlers to be active in ensuring they are well hydrated before taking to the greens, and that they continue good personal practices to ensure health and safety while on the green. 



The ladies have purchased a foldaway bed and linen for use in treating anyone who feels unwell.





And Singles completed. If you were not there for the Final of the Singles both Men's and Ladies were played at the same time. Two great games both going down to the wire. The results were;


Men Dan Gott Defeated Neil Kenneally 25/24 Ladies Sue Kuskey Def Patti Claridge 25/22
