We are not far away from the end of the year and what a great year it has been for the club. Despite a few lock downs during the year and the 2 week freeze on Community Sport, the club has weathered the impacts of COVID quite well.

From a bowling perspective, we have seen great numbers of people bowling during the week which is terrific. We had wonderful Great 8 and Pennant seasons, with all teams doing very well. We have also had many new bowling members join the club and that is great for the health of the club. Well done to all the coaches in the club because the quality of bowls from the new members is just fantastic.

The number one objective of the Board this year was to put the club in the necessary financial position to replace the carpet on Green #1. I am pleased to say the club is well advanced on this objective and when the time comes in 2022, we will be in a good position to replace the carpet and also have the base to begin saving for the replacement of Green #2 in or around 2024 and then to look at shades over the green in or around 2027.

The club has also made some significant other achievements during 2021. We installed a new Solar System which is performing well and will dramatically reduce our power savings. We have renegotiated a number of contracts, for example our POS and our telephone system, to reduce costs and move to more modern systems. We cleaned the roof, purchased a new ride on mower, a new power cleaner, new deep fryer and freezer for the kitchen, new shades along the clubhouse side of both greens, new signage and many other things.

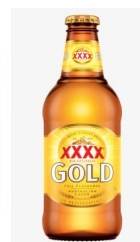
