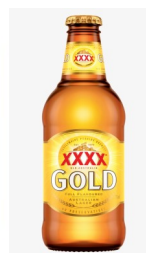
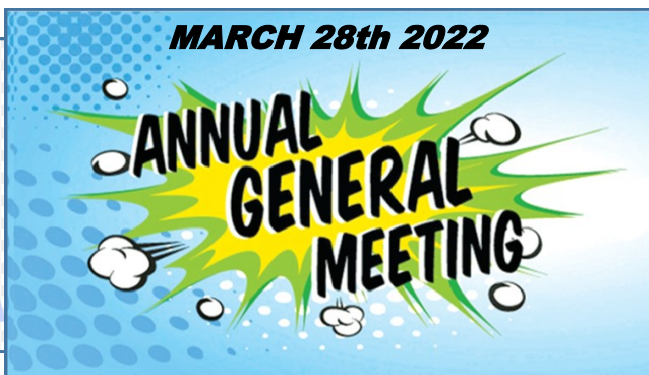
Everyone is getting excited as the 40th Anniversary celebrations approach. It will be a great weekend and we are all appreciative to the organising committee for their hard work to date.

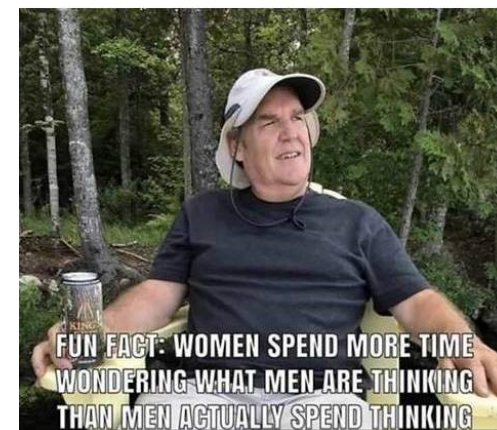

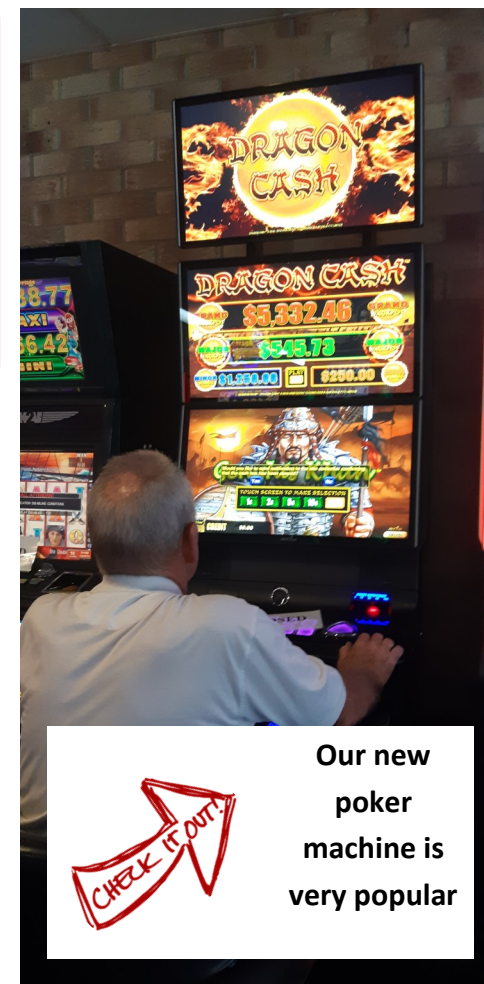
