Hoteliers Day on Wednesday 13th was also a good day for the Club with 112 Bowlers competing and putting well over \$2000 into the Pelican coffers. We invited the Ladies to join with us on the day before with about 20 women playing with us and having a enjoyable day.

At the combined meeting of the MBA & LBA arms, bowling fees were discussed at length and the following was passed with no objections.

Monday & Friday increased by \$1, this being put into the Sinking Fund for New Green/Covers.

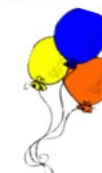
