The Laws and You

"Law" Questions

- Q 1. During a game, players realise that a boundary peg is in the wrong position? What must happen?
- Q 2. In a triples game, team A's second has delivered their bowl but before it comes to rest, team B's second, delivers their bowl. Team A's skip objects to this and calls the umpire. What must happen?
- Q 3. A bowl finishes near the boundary line of the rink. Both Skips look at the bowl and allow play to continue. When the players change ends the thirds agree that the bowl is out of bounds. What should happen?
- Q 4. The skip of team A drove at the head and displaced a number of bowls. Two team B members at the head, were unable to move quickly enough and some of the bowls in motion were displaced by their feet and caused further displacement of the head. What action must be taken?
- Q 5. During a singles game, a delivered bowl from the neighbouring rink comes towards the head. The marker lifts a stationary bowl at the head so that the bowl from the neighbouring rink can pass through to its own rink. Is the marker's action correct?



"You" Answers

A 1. If a player or the Umpire finds a boundary peg in the wrong position, the peg cannot be moved until the end is completed on the rinks effected.

The peg must be put in the correct position by the Umpire or by agreement of the skips or opponents in singles. (Law Book page 70).

- A 2. For the first time this happens, the umpire must warn the player with the skip present. On each occasion after that, the umpire must declare the player's bowl dead. If the bowl has disturbed the head, the opposing skip must choose whether to: replace the head; or leave the head as altered; or declare the end dead. (Law Book page 27).
- A 3. The thirds must refer the matter to the Skips. By looking at the bowl and allowing the game to continue the skips, being in charge of the teams, have indicated that they agree to the bowl being in play. The Skips will agree whether or not a bowl is dead. No member will remove any bowl prior to the agreement of the Skips. Once their attention is drawn to the matter, the Skips must make a decision. If they cannot reach agreement they must ask the umpire to make a decision. (Law Book pages 33 and 59).
- A 4. Skip A must choose whether to: place the bowls where skip A believes they would have come to rest and replace any part of the head disturbed after the displacement; or declare the end dead. (Law Book page 48).
- A 5. No. The marker must stop any bowl that is from a neighbouring rink that could move a bowl or the jack that is at rest at the head. (Law Book page 64).
